Items of Interest from the March and April 2010 Regular Board Meetings:

1. A teacher from École Heritage Immersion School presented a report on the AIM Program – Alternative Instruction Method – for teaching French as a second language.
2. The Principal from École St. Malo School presented a report on the École St. Malo School Hockey Academy which is in its first year.
3. The Senior Administration provided several Monitoring Reports to the Board on priorities that were set in the Board Strategic Plan.
