Red River Valley School Division ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 16 - STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUS



The Red River Valley School Division Board of Trustees believes in the importance of safety on school buses, which includes students conducting themselves in an orderly fashion while waiting for the school bus and riding the school bus.

As per the Public Schools Act (Manitoba) $^{\sim}$ School Buses Regulation 465/88 R $^{\sim}$ 13(1), "The principal of a school whose pupils are being transported in the school bus has the same disciplinary authority over the conduct of the pupils during the period in which they are in, entering upon, or alighting from the school bus, as provided by the regulations under "The Education Administration Act".

The school bus driver is responsible for maintaining order on their bus at all times.

Bus drivers will report misconducts to the principal of that student and the transportation supervisor.

The transportation department will hand out Bus Ridership booklets to all bused students in the fall of each school year.
