Re: COVID-19 UPDATE #21

Earlier today, Education Minister Cullen announced that in response to the COVID-19 situation in our province, all schools in the Red River Valley School Division will continue with remote learning for the remainder of the school year.

Beginning June 14, 2021, unless otherwise directed by public health officials, our schools are able to schedule opportunities for teachers to meet in person with small groups of students (5–6 students). Kindergarten to Grade 12 students learning remotely can be invited to schools during scheduled times for in-person support, assessments, and transition planning.

All applicable public health measures must be followed during in-person visits to the school, including

- Imposing capacity limits determined by the school to ensure two metres of physical distancing
- maintaining cohorts
- limiting, where possible, the amount of time students spend in the facility
- maintaining physical distancing of at least two metres
- · wearing masks, except while seated
- limiting gatherings between students
