Further to update #26, the following conditions/restrictions will be in place from January 10th to January 17th while all schools in RRVSD are in remote learning:

- Suspension of: music classes, wind instruments, community use of schools, all extracurricular activities, field trips.
- All staff are required to wear medical grade masks.
- Masks are required for students in Physical Education classes(indoors).
- No winter town transportation.
- Grades K to 6 remain in cohorts.
- 2 metres of social distancing is in place.
